Points discussed and conclusions arrived:

1. Mr YIP Kam-yuen was elected Chairman of the Committee for the year 2001-2002.

2. The revised Additional Mathematics Curriculum Guide was endorsed in principle.

3. As the Additional Mathematics Curriculum had been revised, the sixth form mathematics curriculum was required to be revised accordingly. Members suggested to form a Joint Working Group with HKEA in early 2002 to consider the revision of the sixth form mathematics curriculum.

4. Members agreed to conduct tryouts of the BC descriptors of mathematics at P3 in some schools.

5. The Ad Hoc Committee on Assessment for Learning (Secondary Mathematics) would be formed to start the compilation of the BC of mathematics at the secondary level.
