

## **CDC Committee on Mathematics Education (2004-2005)**

### **Gist of the First Meeting**

**Date :** 10 December 2004 (Friday)

#### **Points discussed and conclusions arrived:**

1. Mr LUNG Tak-yea was elected Chairman of the Committee for the year 2004-2005.
2. Seven consultation seminars to collect teachers' views on the New Senior Secondary Mathematics Curriculum (NSSMC) had been conducted on 28 October 2004 (pm), 30 October 2004 (pm), 1 November 2004 (pm), 2 November 2004 (am & pm) and 17 December 2004 (am & pm).
3. Members were briefed on the feedback collected from the teachers participated in the seminars. It was reported that the overall discussion atmosphere in the seminars was good.
4. Members discussed issues related to the implementation of School-based Assessment in the NSSMC.
5. The Basic Competency descriptors of Mathematics for Key Stages 1 and 2 had been posted on the web for teachers' reference.
6. The schedule of conducting the Territory-wide System Assessment for P3, P6 and S3 students was reported.
7. Views were sought from members on the provision of school-based curriculum support services to Mathematics teachers. Supports including professional upgrading courses, Chief Executive's Award for Teaching Excellence, consultant teachers from China and teacher secondments were discussed.
