Points discussed and conclusions arrived:

- 1. The Learning Outcomes Framework was the description of a typical progression of students' performance in Mathematics from primary to secondary education. It was mainly for the purposes of assessment for learning and should not be used as a checklist in the learning and teaching of Mathematics.
- 2. Arrangements to assist teachers to deal with problems related to the interfacing of the learning and teaching of Mathematics for KS2 and KS3 students were planned.
- 3. The booklet An English-Chinese Glossary of Terms Commonly Used in the *Teaching of Mathematics in Secondary Schools* would be revised. Points to note in the revision of the booklet were elaborated.
- 4. A great number of professional development programmes for Mathematics teachers were conducted and the general comments on the arrangements of the programmes were positive.
