

## **CDC Committee on Mathematics Education (2009-2010)**

### **Gist of the Second Meeting**

**Date :** 16 April 2010 (Friday)

**Time :** 2:30 p.m.

**Venue:** Room W424, West Block, Education Bureau Kowloon Tong Education Services Centre, 19 Suffolk Road, Kowloon

#### **Points discussed and conclusions arrived:**

1. Two new members were introduced to the Committee members.
2. Members commented on the draft copy of the booklet “數學救生圈”.
3. Experienced primary teachers had been invited to introduce the current scenarios of the learning and teaching of Mathematics in primary schools to the secondary teachers participated in the workshops conducted by the Mathematics Education Section to tackle the interface issues. Similar practices were also carried out in the workshops conducted for primary Mathematics teachers on the interface issues.
4. Students were found to be generally weak in solving geometric problems, particularly problems related to geometric proofs. Members proposed some measures to enhance the learning and teaching of topics in the Measures, Shape and Space Dimension.
5. It was planned to publish a new series of School Mathematics Newsletter in the near future to provide further supports on the learning and teaching of Mathematics for Hong Kong schools.
