

CDC Committee on Mathematics Education (2010-2011)

Gist of the Second Meeting

Date : 30 March 2011 (Wednesday)

Points discussed and conclusions arrived:

1. Invitations had been sent to 13 educational institutes for proposals to bid for the professional service to conduct the survey “An Evaluation Study on the Implementation of the Mathematics Curriculum in Schools”.
2. The survey aimed to examine the implementation of the Mathematics curriculum at the primary, junior secondary and senior secondary levels in Hong Kong. It consisted of a set of questionnaires supplemented by focus group interviews to solicit views from Mathematics panel heads, Mathematics teachers and students.
3. Members expressed their views and expectations on the survey.
4. Three sample SBA tasks were shown to members and they expressed their comments on the tasks.
