

CDC Committee on Mathematics Education (2013 – 2015)
Gist of the Third Meeting

Points discussed and conclusions arrived:

1. The progress of the Medium-term Review of Senior Secondary Mathematics Curriculum was reported. The arrangements of focus group meetings (FGMs) for teachers and principals respectively were well-received by the committee. More sessions of similar FGMs, and a large-scale sharing session for principals, would be organised.
2. The progress of the E-textbook Market Development Scheme (EMADS) was reported and discussed. No e-textbooks under EMADS1 had yet been recommended. First deliverables of e-textbooks under EMADS2 were submitted.
3. The progress of the development of assessment tasks of Learning Progression Framework was reported and discussed. The development of Students' Assessment Repository platform was reported and explained.
4. The discussion on reviewing Mathematics curriculum at KS3 on the interface between the curricula of KS2 and KS3 was raised. No consensus had been reached in the meeting.
