Points discussed and conclusions arrived:

1. The progress of the updating of Mathematics Education KLA Curriculum Guide (KLACG) was reported and discussed. The direction of the updating of KLACG was endorsed. Further views and comments from members would continually be collected and updated draft of KLACG would be submitted for members' comments in next meeting.
2. The progress of the review of Mathematics curriculum (P1 – S6) was reported and discussed. The draft of the updated curriculum content, which was endorsed by One Committee, was tabled and discussed.
3. The progress of the promotion of STEM education was reported and discussed. Different strategies and school experience in STEM education were discussed. It was agreed that mathematics teachers should remember and be pondering over the aims of learning Mathematics when carrying out STEM activities.
