Whole-school Approach to Promote Moral and Civic Education

A school had a shared vision and mission among teachers in fostering students' moral education and whole-person development, which was fully supported by the visionary leadership from the Principal and middle managers in the school.

In 2007, a whole-school Life Education Programme with six core themes for each level of students was first introduced covering "Love Your Life, Share Your Life, Appreciate Your Life, Explore Your Life, Treasure Your Life and Reflect on Your Life". Through the close collaboration among committees and subject panels, and effective use of community resources, the school provided their students with a wide range of OLE following the core themes.

The school also incorporated Aesthetic Development and Moral and Civic Education elements into a campus TV programme named "A Date with the Arts", which was shown during the class teacher periods. Follow-up activities were conducted to further develop students' positive values and attitudes, and reflective habit of mind as self-directed learners.
