The School Physical Fitness Award Scheme (SPFAS) is jointly organised by the Hong Kong Childhealth Foundation (HKCHF), the Physical Fitness Association of Hong Kong, China (HKPFA) and the Education Bureau (EDB). It aims to promote the awareness of health-related physical fitness and engage regularly in physical activities among primary and secondary school students.

3. Students will be awarded a gold, silver or bronze level certificate upon meeting the standards specified in the scheme. Schools interested in joining the scheme have to register online at the HKCHF webpage (<http://hkchf.hku.hk/registration.php>). Equipment subsidy is also available for application from the HKCHF.
