

Curriculum Development Council Committee on Applied Learning (2013-2015)

Gist of the 2nd Meeting

Date of meeting: 20 January 2014

Salient points of the discussion:

1. Regarding the New Academic Structure, the short-term tasks and the medium-term tasks were recapped. Members were briefed on the progress on the piloting on accreditation of Applied Learning courses under the Qualifications Framework and the piloting on early commencement in Secondary 4.
2. The latest development of Applied Learning courses, including implementation of the 2014-16 cohort and the Applied Learning Scholarship of the 2012/13 school year, was reported.
3. The development of the Applied Learning (Chinese) subject was presented. The Committee endorsed the framework of Applied Learning (Chinese) subject for course development work and the establishment of the Ad Hoc Committee on Applied Learning (Chinese).
4. Regarding the provision of Applied Learning courses, it was agreed that the invitation to expression of interest would be launched at the end of January 2014 to invite institutions to express their interest in developing Applied Learning courses (including Applied Learning (Chinese)) which will be delivered commencing in the 2015-17 cohort or thereafter.
