

Curriculum Development Council Committee on Applied Learning (2013-2015)

Gist of the 3rd Meeting

Date of meeting: 25 March 2014

Salient points of the discussion:

1. The Applied Learning findings from the New Academic Structure Medium-term Review School Survey for Principals, conducted from January to March 2014, were highlighted.
2. The launch of Applied Learning courses (2014-16 cohort), including a series of promotion activities, distribution of publicity materials, application and selection arrangement, was reported.
3. The possibility of reporting Applied Learning results in more levels was explored. It was a measure to cater for learner diversity in the long-term development of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination.
4. The recommendation for invitation to submission of course proposal was endorsed. Exploration was made for developing Applied Learning courses (including Applied Learning (Chinese)) which would be delivered from 2015-17 cohort.
