Curriculum Development Council Committee on Applied Learning (2015-2017)

Gist of the Third Meeting

Date of meeting: 8 July 2016

Salient points of the discussion:

- 1. The progress of the follow-up on New Academic Structure review recommendations was reported.
- 2. With the introduction of Learning to Learn 2.0, the Applied Learning Curriculum and Assessment Guide (Senior Secondary Level) Guide would be further updated to align with the latest development.
- 3. Views on the development and implementation of Applied Learning, including measures for strengthening the support to schools were exchanged. It was highlighted that the quality assurance mechanism, focusing on curriculum design, course delivery and assessment and moderation, aims to ensure course quality.
- 4. The course provision of Applied Learning courses was discussed. Members remarked that the development of new Applied Learning courses could enhance course provision and the portfolio of Applied Learning courses, and that the proposed course updating could reflect the latest development of professional and vocational fields. The course list of the 2017-19 cohort was endorsed.
