

CDC News (September 2019)

The 64th CDC Meeting was held on 12 June 2019 (Wednesday). Salient points of the discussion are summarised as follows:

Updates on the latest development of the revised Curriculum Guides of Chinese History (Secondary 1 – 3) and History (Secondary 1 – 3)

- The updates on the latest development of both curricula were reported and discussed.
- Members received both curricula.

Updates on the adapted framework of the revised Chinese History (Secondary 1 - 3) curriculum for non-Chinese speaking (NCS) students

- The updates on the adapted framework and the support measures to schools were reported and discussed.
- Members offered comments on the adapted framework, including adopting an integrative approach in curriculum planning, using different modes of assessment, integrating STREAM/STEM cross-curricular elements, and providing pre-service training to student teachers.
- Members received the adapted framework.

Learning and Teaching of the National Anthem: Supplement to Music Curriculum Guide (Primary 1 – Secondary 3)

- The updates on the Supplement were reported and discussed.
- Members offered comments, including related learning and teaching strategies, arrangements for its effective implementation in class.
- Members received the Supplement.

A.O.B

- The updates on the Basic Competency Descriptors for Key Stage 1 (Primary 1 – 3) Mathematics were reported and received.
- The follow-up actions for the recommendations made in the Audit Report on the cost effectiveness of Radio Television Hong Kong (RTHK)'s production of Education Television (ETV) programmes were reported and discussed. Members offered comments, including developing more diverse multi-media resources and scaling up the commissioning of multimedia resources production.
