The 67th CDC Meeting was held on 23 October 2020 (Friday). Salient points of the discussion are summarised as follows:

Matters arising from the last meeting

• The meeting was informed that the 12th Mainland-HK Curriculum Exchange would be further postponed, tentatively to early 2021.

The initial observations about schools' strategies for supporting learning and teaching amid COVID-19

• The initial observations from focus inspection and the way forward on schools' strategies for supporting learning and teaching amid COVID-19 were reported.

Latest progress of the Task Force on Review of School Curriculum

 The final recommendations and the way forward of the Task Force on Review of School Curriculum's review report were reported.

Latest development of the CDC Standing Committees (SCs)

- The streamlined organisational structure of the CDC was reported and discussed.
- Members agreed to cease the operation of the three SCs under the CDC:
 - > SC on Curriculum Development for Kindergarten and Primary Education
 - > SC on Curriculum Development for Secondary Education
 - > SC on Research, Development and Support
- Members endorsed the setting up of two new SCs under the CDC:
 - SC on Values Education
 - ➤ SC on STEM Education

The key milestones on curriculum development in HK

- The latest progress of the ongoing renewal of the school curriculum was reported.
- The latest development of values education was reported and discussed. Members supported the adding of two priority values and attitudes, namely law-abidingness and empathy, on top of the seven existing ones.

Basic Competency Descriptors of Key Stage 2 and 3 Mathematics

 The proposed updates on the Basic Competency Descriptors of Key Stage 2 and 3 Mathematics were reported and received.

• The Supplementary Notes to *Design and Applied Technology C&A Guide* (Secondary 4-6) were reported and received.

Business, Accounting and Financial Studies C&A Guide (Secondary 4-6)

- The proposed updates on *Business, Accounting and Financial Studies C&A Guide* (Secondary 4-6) were reported and received.
- The Advisory Committee on "Business-related Learning" in Technology Education Key Learning Area at Senior Secondary Level under the CDC was dissolved accordingly upon completion of the related review work. The meeting recorded a vote of thanks to the Chair and Members of the Committee for their valuable contributions.
