

CDC News (November 2021)

The 72nd CDC Meeting was held on 27 October 2021 (Wednesday). Salient points of the discussion are summarised as follows:

Reporting from Standing Committees

- **Standing Committee on Values Education**
 - The progress of revising the *Values Education Curriculum Framework (Pilot version)* was reported.
- **Standing Committee on STEM Education**
 - The progress of the development of the *STEM Education Handbook* and the latest support measures were reported and discussed.

The update of the “Learning to Learn 2+ - The Hong Kong School Curriculum” diagram

- The updating of “Moral and Civic Education” in “Five Learning Experiences” and “Other Learning Experiences” as “Values Education” was endorsed.

- The major updates of the *Chinese Language Education Key Learning Area Curriculum Guide (Primary 1 - Secondary 6)*, *Chinese Language Curriculum Guide (Primary 1 - 6)* and *Chinese Language Curriculum Guide (Secondary 1 - 3)* were noted.
