

## **CDC News (June 2022)**

The 74th CDC Meeting was held on 27 April 2022 (Wednesday). Salient points of the discussion were summarised as follows:

### **Reporting from Standing Committees**

- **Standing Committee on STEM Education**
  - The progress of the development of the *STEM Education Handbook*, the proposed strategies for further promoting STEM Education and the update of the IT Learning Target were noted.
- **Standing Committee on Values Education**
  - Members noted the progress of the tryout of *Values Education Curriculum Framework (Pilot Version)* and the final version of the Framework would be tentatively published in the 2022/23 school year.

### **The new arrangements for Other Languages in the 2025 HKDSE Examination and Beyond**

- The proposed new arrangements for Other Languages in the 2025 HKDSE Examination and Beyond were reported and discussed.

### **The progress of updating the *Primary Education Curriculum Guide***

- The progress of updating the *Primary Education Curriculum Guide* was reported and discussed.

### **The progress of the follow-up work of the recommendations of the Task Force on Review of School Curriculum**

- The progress of the follow-up work of the recommendations of the Task Force on Review of School Curriculum was reported and discussed, including the provision of professional development activities to enhance school leaders'/teachers' capacity for planning the school curriculum and STEM education, and the organisation of diversified student activities to strengthen values education.

### **A.O.B.**

- The sharing on ICT curriculum of Junior Secondary was noted.
- The updates on the development of Applied Learning were reported, including the provision of a wider range of ApL courses for students.
- The progress of the revision of the Life and Society curriculum (S1-S3) was reported.
- The highlight of CDI's latest support measures in promoting self-directed learning in the

time of pandemic was reported, including learning and teaching resources, such as theme-based reading, interactive quiz games and animated short videos, relating to different Key Learning Areas / subjects / curriculum areas.

- Members noted the 12th Mainland-HK Curriculum Exchange Meeting was further postponed.
