## Points discussed and conclusion arrived:

1. Mr. Yau Yat-heem was nominated and elected Chairman for the year 2002-2003.

- 2. To brief the meeting about the background, the objectives, the scope and present situation on developing an union cataloguing system for primary and secondary schools. Details were the Union Catalog was originally developed by Hong Kong Teacher-librarian's Association under the Quality Education Fund to provide a standard bibliographic database to facilitate resources sharing and collaboration among school libraries. While starting from 2002, the Education Department of Hong Kong together with the Hong Kong Teacher-librarian's Association implemented and maintained the system to all schools by phases.
- 3. The meeting was informed on the textbook related issues and the Chairman concluded the discussion and opined that the direction of the development on the textbook issues should be well set and discussed in its Ad Hoc Committee and the publicity of the existing learning and teaching resources produced by the Education Department to schools should be promoted.
- 4. Members were briefed on the background, purposes and present situation on cyber ethics for students and youth in Hong Kong. Members agreed that it was a hot issue discussed in the society. Members endorsed the proposal on setting up the Ad Hoc Committee to recommend strategies conducive to the development of resources for Cyber Ethics in Hong Kong.
- 5. Members were reported on the latest situation and development of Basic Competency Assessment and BCA remediation section. To illustrate and elaborate what resources developed in line with the implementation of BCA, the meeting was informed that remediation resources were located at http://cd.ed.gov.hk/assessment/bca/chi/bca\_c.htm.
