Points discussed and conclusion arrived:

1. Mr. WONG Kwong-wai, Raymond was nominated and elected as the Chairman for the years 2007-2009.
2. Mr. IP Tang-ping, Simon was nominated and endorsed as a Co-opted member by this committee for one year.
3. As the Ad Hoc Committee on Development of Information Literacy Framework had completed its tasks, the meeting endorsed its dissolution.
4. The latest development of the learning resource support for the New Senior Secondary (NSS) curriculum was reported. Members were informed that learning resource packages were being developed by various sections of CDI to support the NSS curriculum. Members agreed that the quality of the textbooks for NSS was very important to the successful implementation of NSS curriculum. The Chairman concluded that ample time should be given to teachers for NSS textbook selection. The Recommended Textbook List for all NSS subjects should also be released as early as possible.
5. The latest development of ETV was reported. There were currently three modes to deliver ETV programmes namely, Broadcast, Internet and VCD. It was planned to include teachers and parents as the target audiences of ETV. Members agreed that ETV provided inspiring learning ideas to students and the programme contents should be kept in close relationship with the school curriculum. Members expressed their concern on the quality of production by RTHK as well as the contract production companies. They thanked EDB for their continuous engagement to assure the quality of the ETV programmes.
