Gist of the Fourth Meeting of CDC Committee on Physical Education (2004-2005) held on 7 July 2005

- 1. The minutes of the last meeting held on 29 April 2005 were confirmed with no amendment.
- 2. Judging from the feedbacks collected from the second NSS consultation seminars, members agreed that the teachers showed much concern on assessment, particularly issues related to school-based assessment (SBA); Other areas of concern included the three newly added topics (movement analysis, sports psychology, and sports management), the likely increased workload, and the implementation of the curriculum.
- 3. It was suggested that various assessment models would be discussed in forthcoming focused group meetings.
- 4. It was anticipated that the weightings of different parts of the curriculum as well as the detail arrangement for SBA would not be fixed until the publication of the Curriculum & Assessment Guide by the end of 2006. Yet, members also understood that the examination rubrics could still be further amended thereafter.
- 5. It was confirmed that resource materials and professional development programmes would be developed to support teachers implementing the new curriculum.
