Gist of the First Meeting of the CDC Committee on Physical Education (2005-2006) held on 24 October 2005

- 1. Mr. KWOK Wai-cheung was elected the Chairperson of the CDC Committee on PE for 2005/06.
- 2. The Secretary delivered a report on the feedback from the public since last meeting on the Proposed New Senior Secondary PE Curriculum and Assessment Framework.
- 3. Members agreed to the benchmarking report submitted by the Wilf Malcolm Institute of Educational Research (WMIER) that the PE curriculum content was largely "scientific" but considered such a design essential as it was in line with the curriculum objectives. Hence, it should be retained.
- 4. Members disagreed to the WMIER report's suggestion to increase the weighting of school school-based assessment (SBA) to more than 30%.
- 5. Members suggested that in the next round of benchmarking, if any, comparable PE curriculums, such as those in the UK and Australia, should be chosen as far as possible.
- 6. Members were informed of the schedule and strategies of the professional development programmes for supporting the Proposed New Senior Secondary PE Elective Curriculum.
