Gist of the Second Meeting of the CDC Committee on Physical Education (2021-2023) held on 28 April 2022

- 1. The minutes of the 1st CDCC on PE Meeting (2021-2023) were confirmed without any amendments.
- 2. Members were briefed on the progress of the "Active Students, Active People" (ASAP) Campaign. They appreciated the effort made by the PE Section to offer a wide range of student activities, Professional Development Programmes (PDPs) and Learning and Teaching (L&T) materials to benefit more than 3 000 students and 1 100 teachers.
- 3. Members were briefed on the progress of the professional support measures provided by the PE Section in the 2021/22 s.y., such as professional support to members of different learning circles/networks, PDPs, and L&T materials. Members' observations and views were noted.
- 4. Members were briefed and discussed on the contingency arrangement of PE activities during the early school break. Positive feedback was received, especially on using the apps to record the number of successful trials in the eight different fitness exercises. Members' observations and views were noted.
- 5. Members were briefed and discussed on the optimisation of the SS elective subjects and the arrangement of HKDSE PE Examination in 2022 and 2023. They welcomed the aforementioned arrangements and their views were noted.
- 6. Members were briefed and discussed on the progress of the STEM Education in PE. Members' observations and views were noted.
