

CDC Committee on Science Education (2015-2017)
Gist of Third Meeting

Date of meeting: 13 June 2016

1. The minutes of the previous meeting held on 25 February 2016 were confirmed without any amendments.
2. The latest progress of promoting STEM education and the way forward were reported and discussed. Members generally agreed with the way forward on promoting STEM education.
3. The progress of updating the Science Education KLA Curriculum Guide was reported and discussed. Members' views would be considered and incorporated for refinement of the draft Guide. As the Curriculum Guide had to align with the Secondary School Curriculum Guide and the Curriculum Guides of other KLAs, the secretariat of CDCC(SE) would continue to make necessary refinement and revision of wording for alignment purpose.
4. The progress of the review of Science (S1-3) curriculum was reported and discussed. Members generally agreed with the details of the framework of each of the 14 Units. The final draft of the Science (S1-3) curriculum would be circulated to all members by email for endorsement in August 2016.
5. Members discussed about the feedback collected on the promotion of STEM education at primary level and were briefed the updates of primary General Studies curriculum. Workshops on promoting STEM education in primary General Studies would be organised. District network activities would continue to be organised.
