CDC Committee on Science Education (2015-2017)

Gist of Sixth Meeting

Date of meeting: 4 July 2017

1. The minutes of the previous meeting held on 28 March 2017 were confirmed without

any amendments.

2. The progress of promoting STEM education and the way forward were reported and

discussed. Members put forward views and suggestions, in particular on the use of

funds and other resources, for implementing STEM education in schools.

3. The progress of updating of the Science Education Key Learning Area Curriculum

Guide was reported and discussed. The draft English version of the Guide was

uploaded onto the EDB's website, and the Chinese version would be available in due

course.

4. The progress of the work in relation to the updated Science (S1-3) curriculum was

reported and discussed. There were different support measures, including piloting the

learning and teaching of new topics in schools, development of resource materials and

organisation of teacher training programmes in this school year. The support

measures would be continued in the coming school year. Regarding the updating of

the Science (S1-3) Glossary, the progress of work of the relevant Working Group was

reported.

5. The strategies for catering for learner diversity in various senior secondary subjects in

the Science Education KLA were reported and discussed. Members agreed that space

should be created to students for better learning, and they also put forward other views

and suggestions about catering for learner diversity.
