

CDC Committee on Science Education (2015-2017)
Gist of Fourth Meeting

Date of meeting: 27 September 2016

1. The minutes of the previous meeting held on 13 June 2016 were confirmed without any amendments.
2. The latest progress of promoting STEM education and the way forward were reported and discussed. Members agreed with the way forward on promoting STEM education.
3. The progress of updating the Science Education KLA Curriculum Guide (SEKLA Guide) was reported and discussed. Members expressed views on learning and teaching and about provision of examples, and would like to read the key messages of the Guide. The meeting endorsed the draft SEKLA Guide.
4. The progress of the review of Science (S1-3) curriculum was reported and discussed. The updated Science (S1-3) curriculum, as a supplement to the SEKLA Guide, was circulated to all members in August 2016 and subsequently endorsed.
5. The progress of the review of primary General Studies curriculum (GS Curriculum) was reported and discussed. The development of resource materials and professional development programmes (PDP) for GS curriculum were briefed.
