CDCC on Technology Education (1999-2000) Gist of the Fourth Meeting
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Date : 3 July 2000

Points discussed and conclusion arrived:

1. The Chairman told members that all the Ad Hoc Committee Members under the CDCC on TE were invited to attend the meeting as observers and join in the discussion of the Development of the Technology Education Curriculum Framework.
2. Members agreed to establish two working parties under the Ad Hoc Committee on the Development of Technological Subjects to review the CDC Syllabuses for Fashion & Clothing (S4-5) and Accommodation & Catering Services (S4-5).
3. Members agreed to establish the Ad Hoc Committee on Teacher Training to Implement the New Technical Curriculum to advise the Chief Executive of CDI on teacher training.
4. The Chairman welcomed the 22 Ad Hoc Committee Members under the CDCC on TE who were present and invited them to join in the discussion.
5. The Chairman and Vice-chairman briefed members on the review of the Technology Education curriculum framework by local and international scholars and advisors, the seminars conducted on the proposed framework and a proposed new subject for students not in the science stream, Integrated Science and Technology.
6. Members discussed the draft framework and agreed that
 - a clearer direction of the framework should be set after the five writing-up sessions to be conducted in July and August 2000.
 - the messages would be properly delivered to teachers, the industries and the public at large.
 - the role of teachers should not be merely providers of information.
