Points discussed and conclusion arrived:

- Report of the two forums for Technology Education in Hong Kong held in December 1999 and a summary report of four submissions lodged with the Department as responses to *A Holistic Review of the Hong Kong School Curriculum: Proposed Reforms* were presented to the Committee for discussion.
- 2. Members gave comments on the draft curriculum framework for Technology Education and the Committee adopted the framework subject to further development.
- 3. The information paper *Connecting New Technical Curriculum with Curriculum 2000* was adopted and would be forwarded to the Council for endorsement.
- 4. Members agreed to set up the *Ad Hoc Committee on the Development of Information Technology Learning Targets* to oversee the development of the titled learning targets.
- 5. Members gave comments on the two glossaries of terms, *Design & Technology* and *Electronics & Electricity*, and agreed that they should be amended and circulated to members for endorsement.

 - a. It was agreed that Mr. Lam Yat-fung, James, the Principal of Lions College, should be invited to serve the *CDCC on TE* as a co-opted member.
 - b. It was raised that deliberations on the 3+3+4 structure should be made in future meetings.
 - c. Members were briefed on the progress of the development on Technology Education in the primary subject *General Studies*.
 - d. Members were briefed on the *Benjamin Franklin Science and Technology Program* based at the Pennsylvania States University in the U.S.A.
