CDCC on Technology Education (2000-2001) Gist of the Third Meeting

Points discussed and conclusion arrived:

1. Members agreed that a critical success factor for the new subject *Integrated Science and Technology* lied in its acceptance by end users such as parents, students, employers, and universities and that development of the new subject should be well publicized.
2. Members discussed the feedback on the curriculum reform related to Technology Education.
3. Members discussed the proposed content of the Technology Education Curriculum Guide and Subject Guides.
4. The need to set up an ad hoc committee on Assessment for Learning in the near future was discussed. It was agreed that the Secretary would invite members to join the proposed Ad Hoc Committee in due course.
5. Members were briefed on the upcoming Research and Development projects and the teacher development courses to support the curriculum reforms in Technology Education.
6. The Vice-chairman appealed to the members to consider joining the projects when they receive the circular in May. He also informed members of the launching of an exemplar mini-bank on the internet.
