

**Gist of the Ninth Meeting of
CDC Committee on Technology Education (2001-2002)**

Points discussed and conclusion arrived

- Mr. NG Sui-kou, the retiring Chairman, was re-elected unopposed to be the Chairman for the year 2001-2002.
- The minutes of the meeting held on 4 July 2001 were confirmed without amendment.
- After some deliberations, Members formally endorsed the name “Computer and Information Technology” proposed by the Joint Working Group of the Ad Hoc Committee and HKEA Subject Committee on the Development of Computer Education.
- Members provided further comments on the development of Science and Technology curriculum.
- Members noted the progress on the development of the Advanced Level Principles of Accounts.
- Members generally agreed with the directive of the Collaborative Research and Development (“Seed”) Projects in Technology Education, i.e. for more ready schools to develop their own school-based models for dissemination to other schools.
- Members noted the progress on the Implementation of the New Technical Curriculum.
- After some deliberation, Members accepted the proposed Year Plan. The Chairman agreed to convey the message on the aims of TE, which is applicable to the development of the new senior secondary curriculum, to the Standing Committee on Curriculum Development for S4-S7. The aims are to provide the smooth transition of secondary school leavers from school to workplace and to provide them with qualifications for their further studies, work or both.
