Points discussed and conclusion arrived

- The minutes of the Twelfth Meeting held on 7 October 2002 were confirmed without amendments.
- Members endorsed the final draft of S4-5 Computer and Information Technology Curriculum and Assessment Guide for issuing to schools for implementation commencing September 2003.
- After much deliberation, the Meeting endorsed the S4-5 Science and Technology curriculum for implementation.
- The meeting was informed that the Ad Hoc Committee on the Development of Learning Modules in "Healthy Living" was formally established on 4 March 2003.
- The proposal on the change of subject title for Principles of Accounts originated from Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA) Sixth Form Principles of Accounts Subject Committee and HKEAA CE Accounts and Commerce Subject Committee dated October 2002 had been withdrawn and no further action would be required.
- Members endorsed the proposal for the introduction of the Career Oriented Diversified Curriculum for Senior Secondary Students to schools.
- The Committee considered combining two existing subjects, Engineering Science and Physics at both S4-5 and S6-7 levels. It was agreed to bring this issue to the related Ad Hoc Committee for deliberation and recommendations.
- Members supported to form another Ad Hoc Committee to review the AS-level Computer Applications and A-level Computer Studies.
