Gist of the Fourteenth Meeting of CDC Committee on Technology Education (2002-2003)

Points discussed and conclusion arrived

- The minutes of the Thirteenth Meeting held on 7 March 2003 were confirmed without amendments.
- Members discussed the latest progress of the Ad-hoc Committee on the Development of Computer Education including the dissemination of the Curriculum and Assessment Guide of the Computer and Information Technology (S4-5).
- Members deliberated on the latest progress on the work of the Ad-hoc Committee on the Development of Science & Technology. As the work entrusted to the Committee had been completed, the proposal to dissolve the Committee was endorsed.
- The meeting was informed of the progress on the Career Oriented Diversified Curriculum (CODC) for senior secondary students.
- Members discussed the way forward in reviewing S4-7 subjects under Technology Education Key Learning Area (TEKLA) in order to pave the way to the New Senior Secondary Curriculum. The proposal on the core and extension module structure was explained.
- TE subject officers were invited to report on some of the measures to support the implementation of the TE KLA Curriculum Guide (P1-S3). The measures included seed projects, modules development and teachers' development programmes.
- As the work entrusted to the Ad-hoc Committee on the Development of Business Subjects had been completed, Members endorsed the proposal to dissolve the Ad-hoc Committee.
