- Members were briefed on the progress of the medium-term review of Business, Accounting and Financial Studies, and the proposed recommendations of Health Management and Social Care as well as Technology and Living. No adverse comment was raised by Members.
- Members were informed that the updated Chinese version of the Basic Education Curriculum Guide (Primary 1 to 6) had been uploaded onto the EDB webpage. Besides, the Computer Awareness Programmes for primary schools had also been updated, whereas the Secondary Education Curriculum Guide as well as the Technology Education Key Learning Area Curriculum Guide would be updated soon.
- Members shared their views in connection to the implementation of the TE curriculum, including: the allocation of lesson time to TEKLA at junior secondary level in some schools was still less than 8%; different modes of curriculum implementation could be adopted by schools in order to provide a broad and balance curriculum to students; professional development programmes on enhancing teacher's pedagogical knowledge in teaching programming as well as the implementation of TE curriculum could be arranged.
