

## **CDC News (September 2024)**

The 3rd meeting of CDC Standing Committee on STEAM Education (2023-2025) was held on 24 June 2024 (Monday). Salient points of the discussion were summarised as follows:

- The various key initiatives and related support measures for stepping up the promotion of STEAM education in schools were reported and discussed, including: –
  - the preparation for implementation of the new Primary Science curriculum;
  - the implementation of the I&T curriculum modules on coding education and AI at the upper primary and junior secondary levels respectively;
  - the implementation of the STEAM learning modules in Junior Secondary Science;
  - the launching of the Pilot Scheme on Introducing Mathematical Modelling relating to the Primary Mathematics curriculum and the implementation of the Certificate Course of Mathematical Modelling in Secondary Mathematics;
  - the curriculum renewals of subjects in the Science Education and Technology Education Key Learning Areas;
  - the progress of setting up of school-based student talent pools and the enhanced support measures for the grooming gifted students with talents in STEAM; and
  - the provision of professional development programmes for STEAM coordinators/teachers; and the organisation of STEAM related activities for students.
