## 1. Objectives

This support service aims to:

- To provide a platform for teachers to develop a deeper understanding of SDGs-informed cross-curricular reading, share the challenges encountered, jointly explore the coping strategies and reflect on pedagogical practices to enhance learning and teaching effectiveness
- To build a collaborative sharing culture within and across schools to foster the sustainable development of the school curriculum
- To provide a platform for participants to engage in professional exchanges regarding various curriculum initiatives through diversified support activities, which include the following in general:
  - theme-based workshops
  - inter-school networking activities (e.g. inter-school lesson observation, inter-school visits, experience sharing)
  - 1-2 face-to-face/online meetings with language support officers (e.g. consultation, collaborative lesson planning)
