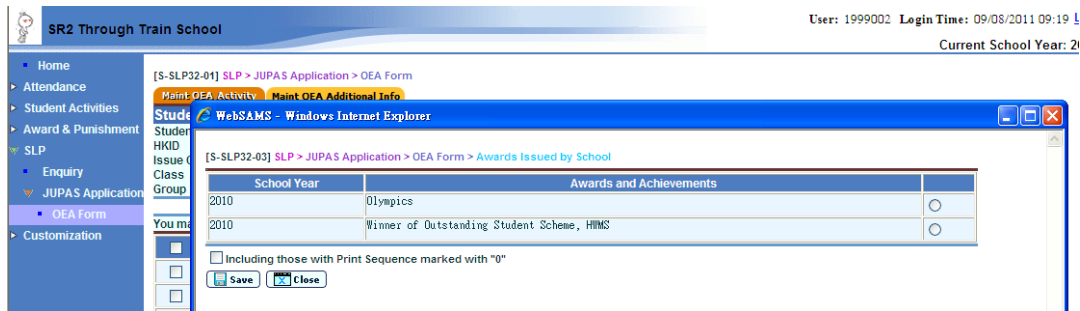

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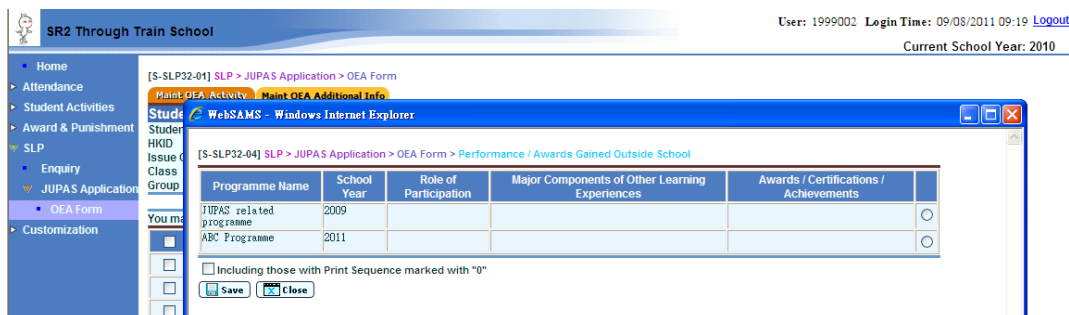

Students have to input

JUPAS OEA coded activity**i. Using keyword search**

Students could use keyword search to select JUPAS OEA coded activity from a pre-defined activity list. All JUPAS OEA coded activities have pre-defined category code (01- Community Service, 02-Career-related Experiences, 03-Physical Development, 04-Aesthetic Development, 05-Moral and Civic Education, 06-Others).

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ii. Use mapped JUPAS OEA coded activity

If the Other Learning Experiences/Awards issued by school /Performance / awards gained outside school has already been mapped to a JUPAS OEA coded activity by school, the OEA coded activity would be displayed automatically. Student could directly adopt the code if that fits his/her programme or he/she could still make use of keyword search to select another JUPAS OEA coded activity.

Non-coded activity

If there is no matching code from JUPAS OEA coded activity, student has to choose “non-coded activity”. The activity code would be stamped “00000”. The programme name would be automatically extracted as the activity name. The category code would be stamped as “06” (Category “Others”). For such activity, student has to input the description. *The original programme description would be displayed in coming versions.*

Other OEA information

- i. Year From: The beginning year of the programme. This is extracted from SLP record. The beginning year could not be adjusted to a year before the original data. If there is an adjustment on the data, an asterisk would be displayed on the field when teacher browse the record.
- ii. Year To: The end year of the programme. This is extracted from SLP record. The end year could be adjusted to a year later than the original data. If there is an adjustment on the data, an asterisk would be displayed on the field when teacher browse the record.
- iii. Participation: There are two types of participation: Attended as school activity / Attended as non-school activity. For Other Learning Experiences and Award issued by school Programme, it would be set as default “Attended as school activity”. For Performance / awards gained outside school, it would be set as default “Attended as non-school activity”.
- iv. Award-bearing activity: There are two types: Yes / No. This indicates if there is any award for the programme.
- v. Award Nature: There are three types for award-bearing activity: By competition, By nomination, By participation. There are two types for non-award-bearing activity: By nomination, By participation.
- vi. Participation Mode: There are three types: Leader, Committee Member, Member/Participant.
- vii. Award Type: There are four types for award-bearing activity: Champion/Gold Medal, 1st Runner-up/2nd Runner-up/Silver/Bronze Medal, Other Awards, No Award.
