# I·CARE Framework

We set clearly defined targets for all-round development. The I·CARE framework was launched in October 2009. Under the framework, we provide a wide range of non-formal learning opportunities to cover five key areas of whole-person growth:

- I - Integrity and moral development
- C - Creativity and intellectual development
- A - Appreciation of life and aesthetic development
- R - Relationships and social development
- E - Energy and wellness

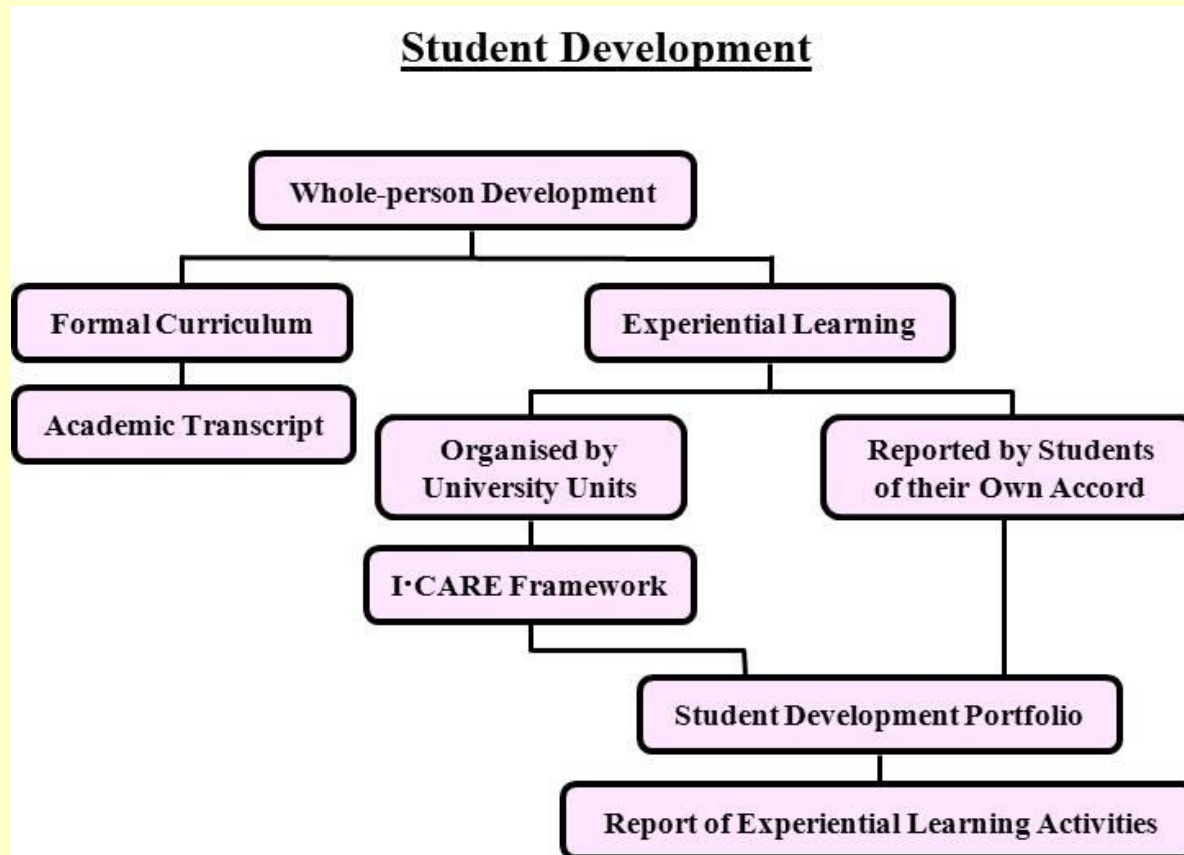
