Management Level

1 management staff oversee the whole process (e.g. VP); reshuffling manpower as appropriate

• 2 'maps' – "System map" & "Road map" towards

submission

• 3 strands of data –

I. OEA activity data;

II. Write-up of Additional Info;

III. SRR info

- 4 key players: Career teachers, Class teachers, IT experts, OLE co-ordinators – training and briefing
- Alternative plan(s) drawn out

Focus Group Interviews on 2 June



Technical Level:


- Identify the 'right' people to be in-charge;
- Understand own system (e.g. WebSAMS, eClass, My IT School) details of uploading to JUPAS;
- Work out the details & feasibility of proposed alternative plan(s) (e.g. non-electronic means, direct entry to JUPAS interface, uploading OEA in excel files direct to JUPAS)
- Plan for preliminary sorting in Sept; early submission (Nov/ Dec – OEA);

Focus Group Interviews on 2 June



Student/Student Learning Level:

- Students' positive understanding and attitude are key of success; Communication strategy;
- Try seizing opportunities to enable students to learn how to present themselves – essential life skills (e.g. making resume approach, language)
- Facilitate students to make informed choice incl.
 course information



Road map of SRR – A school example

Try building on existing, readily available results / criteria Aug

Decide what to submit that best reflect students' performance in school

Collection of information from class teachers and subject teachers via school-based system/hardcopy

e.g. S.5 exam, S.6 first term exam, project works, teachers' observation (some subjects), assessment tasks, portfolios, mock exam...



Checking of information and uploading by batch

Some features in WebSAMS for supporting "uploading by school"



- Students could access their own data (OEA)
- Activity mapping is available (OEA)
- Can submit by batches (OEA)
- Provide function to work out the percentiles (SRR)



Roles of Class teachers



- Continue providing guidance to their students
- Work with career teachers (as resource persons) in students' academic / career planning
- Provide advice on OEA activity selection and write up self-account/additional information in the preparation of SLP and JUPAS OEA information

Some reflection from schools...

- "Simple is beauty; Minimum is fine..."
- "It is okay to play healthy skepticism on IT system..."
- "Procedures that involve hard copies are not bad ideas..."
- "Primitive means maybe good enough for the first time..."
- "Having alternative plans is normal in modern practice....
