

Example5: Developing Students' Competencies in Arts Appraising and their Lifelong Interest in the Arts

- In order to provide a broad and balanced curriculum, School E allocates one structured arts lesson per cycle to provide students with various arts programmes, such as music, drama, photography, musical performance, visual arts and image design.
