

Example: The ‘Good Samaritan’ Project

In order to help students to put “caring for others in the community” into action, a “Good Samaritan” project was launched in SKH Bishop Baker Secondary School as early as in 1995. This was a Religious Studies extension activity for all S3 students. Students had to participate in some kinds of Community Service, e.g.

- Flag day
- Visiting centres of deprived communities
- Fund raising activities
- Clean HK campaigns
- Services provided to welfare agencies....

In collaboration with certain NGOs, the school offered a wide range of community service opportunities for students. Students were asked to reflect on what they learned throughout the process of serving. Their participation in Community Service was also recorded and recognised by the school. Building on these prior experiences, the project will be extended to SS level.
