² To ensure sufficient structured learning opportunities for students in AD, Music and VA lessons will be arranged as regular timetabled lessons for all NSS. They will be arranged alternatively with Ethics and religion throughout the 3 years. In actual practice, our school will arrange 2 lessons of Music and VA lessons for 2 consecutive weeks, which will be taken up by Ethics and religion for the next week, and then Music and VA lessons again for the next 2 weeks, and so on. Approximately 24 hours will be allocated for S4 & 5 respectively and 19 hours for S6.
