¹ Sports Friday are after-school sports activities for all students. Different kinds of sport activities are offered to students, such as badminton, soccer, bicycle, table tennis, taekwondo, fencing, netball and handball etc.

² To ensure sufficient structured learning opportunities in AD, we arrange 2 Talent Class periods per week. Talent Class program offers various art subjects for students to choose and to participate, such as music, visual arts, dance and drama, etc.

³ Extended Talent Class is arranged outside school hours by school for students to participate, such as public exhibition, performance and competition. As part of the scheme, students are also required to attend concerts or exhibitions that are related to the art subjects they take.

⁴ A Chinese village visit programme will be provided for Grade 10 students. Services like teaching primary school kids and helping farm work for the farmers will be arranged.
