We provide AD opportunities to S.4 students in the form of Music lesson. But for S.4E, students will only join the Young Audience Scheme, in which students will participate in a total of 6 - 8 hours of AD appreciation sessions. This curriculum will be reviewed next year to ensure sufficient AD entitlement for all S.4 students. For S.5 and S.6, all students will take Chinese Arts Appreciation lesson.
