Achievements	 Success: Students could produce deliverable outcomes, including the pamphlet and website with a high standard. The tour was successfully carried out and the participants from another school also appreciated our tour guides who could articulate the information clearly and help them to understand more about sustainable development. 			
	 The concept of sustainable development should be introduced to the participants before the trip. More promotion should be made to encourage more students to join the tour. 			
Student Feedback	 The design of tour allowed students to understand the concept of sustainable development and put it into practice. Students could evaluate the extent to which the development of each site was in line with sustainable development. Students could promote the idea of sustainable development to the participants.
