1. Objectives

This support service aims to:

- enhance professional exchange between Mainland Expert Teachers (METs) and Hong Kong teachers through a school attachment programme; and
- foster a research culture in schools through promoting STEAM education in the General Studies/Primary Science curriculum.

2. Foci of Support

- Assist schools to design and implement STEAM learning activities and projects.
- Cultivate students’ curiosity in science and technology as well as to develop their procedural knowledge in scientific investigations through “hands-on and minds-on” activities.
- Introduce effective learning and teaching strategies to enhance students’ abilities to integrate and apply knowledge and skills in science and technology to solve daily life problems, through cross-school professional activities and diversified collaboration modes.
- Promote students’ understanding of the culture of our country and its latest developments to foster a sense of national identity through STEAM education.

3. Mode of Support

- METs provide on-site collaboration (normally 1-2 days per week) with Hong Kong teachers for promoting STEAM education
