
# Title of School-Based Support Service (Learning Community)

# 1. Objectives

This support service aims to:

• establish a cross-school collaboration platform that enables teachers from different primary schools to explore the planning and implementation of learning and teaching design based on "Inquiry and Investigation", facilitating experience sharing and resources exchange.

## 2. Foci of Support

- Enhance teacher leaders' curriculum planning capacity to infuse "Inquiry and Investigation" in the learning and teaching of Mathematics at the upper primary level.

- Promote professional exchange and collaboration on "Inquiry and Investigation", through thematic discussion, cross-school lesson observation, and joint-school sharing.
- Enhance curriculum planning and pedagogical design in response to school development needs through on-site meetings.
