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1. Objectives

This support service aims to:

- support schools to prepare for the implementation of the Primary Science curriculum, and to enhance teachers' confidence and capabilities in teaching Primary Science for developing students' science process and problem-solving skills, and fostering their curiosity and interests in learning science.

- Enhance teachers' professional capacities and deepen their understanding of the Primary Science curriculum, with a view to facilitating the planning and implementation of the curriculum.
- Facilitate experience sharing and resources exchange on specific topics among schools through joint-school sharing and cluster meetings.
