

Tips for arranging a life-wide learning experience at the Hong Kong Heritage Museum

- Visit the Museum's website before you design a visit for students. It provides useful information about exhibits that help you design the life-wide learning experience at the Museum.
- Arrange teachers to visit the museum themselves first before arranging a student visit. This allows teachers to design a route catering for the specific needs and interests of their students.
- Consider designing a theme for your visit, such as 'To explore how eastern and western culture meet in Hong Kong'. This will make the learning experience more focused and meaningful to students.
- Communicate with the Museum to check if the exhibits you intend for students to see are still on display in respective galleries. The Museum changes the exhibits from time to time.
- Connect the life-wide learning experience at the Hong Kong Heritage Museum to values education, particularly in fostering a stronger sense of national identity. The integrated learning experience is more impactful to the development of students.
- Take group photos of all students and teachers at the entrance of the Hong Kong Heritage Museum!
