What is Cloud Accounting?





Do we need to shift?







Cloud Accounting vs Traditional Accounting?



Requires **software installation** and regular **updates**, new **licenses and fees** for database

Manual backups needed



Cloud-based

No software installment needed

Updates and backups arranged by software provider





Limited access on selected computers with required software only

Cloud-based

Remote access to data anytime from any device connected to internet







Single-user access:

Data sharing is not easy, as only one person can access the information



Cloud-based

Multiple-user access: Accountants and clients share data and collaborate with ease





High maintenance cost along with expensive hardware




Cloud-based

Pay as you go: Payment on **subscription** basis with **free trial** use, paying for the services needed only





Server shutdown leads to data loss



Cloud-based

Data encryption and access with own password. Even if one server shuts down, data is still accessible on other devices








Examples of Accounting Automation

Examples of Cloud Accounting Software





Japan's cloud accounting startup raised <u>\$30M at \$250M valuation</u> ahead of IPO

- Founded in March 2013
- <u>\$2.5 million Series A</u> from DCM and Infinity Ventures in 2013
- <u>\$12 million Series B</u> came in two parts in 2014, the first in April and the second in October
- <u>\$30 million Series C round</u> that took its total raised funding to <u>\$43 million</u> in 2015
- Share of the cloud accounting market in Japan: <u>38% in 2015, 44% in 2017</u> and still growing









Get daily bank feeds Reconcile bank transactions View the dashboard




Direct bank feeds for Hong Kong

- → No need to import bank statements




